


1 Installing your software

- Insert the installation DVD into the DVD-ROM device. Follow the on-screen instructions to install Roxio Software.

2 Installing your hardware

- Connect the Video Capture USB device to a USB 2.0 port on your computer.
- An on-screen notification will appear when the device is ready to use.

3 Connecting analog video devices

- Connect the outputs of your analog video device to the inputs of the hardware. Your Roxio Video Capture USB is now ready to use.
