



Creating Perfect Cell Phone Photos with Roxio Easy Media Creator 10

- Optimizing images shot with a Cell Phone Camera with Mobile Photo Doctor
- Customizing photos for Cell Phone display with Mobile PhotoFit

Introduction:

If you shoot lots of photos with your cell phone, you've probably seen some that are too dark and blurry to share. If you like showing off photos on your cell, perhaps you've noticed that pictures that look great on your computer may be too tiny for your cell phone, or have distracting black bars around the edges.

Let's look at two new features in Easy Media Creator 10; one that improves the quality of photos taken with your built-in phone camera and another that lets you optimize photos you send to your phone so they fit within its display.

I. Optimizing Cell Phone Photos with Mobile Photo Doctor

Let's start by learning how to use Mobile Photo Doctor.

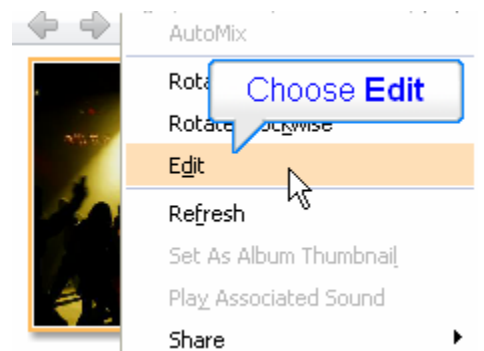
1. Start in Easy Media Creator Suite 10, then click **Media and Devices**, then **Manage Media**.

This opens Roxio's Media Manager.








3. Choose the target image, then **right click** and Click **Edit**.

This opens the image in Roxio PhotoSuite 10.



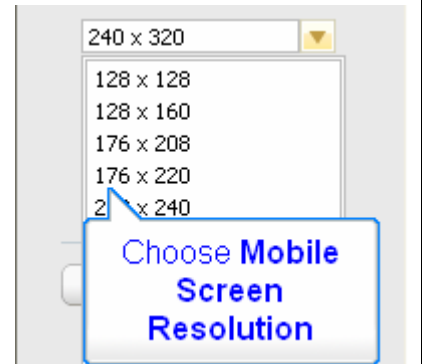
4. In the tool panel on the left, Click **Mobile Photo Tools**, then click **Mobile Photo Doctor**.



<p>5. Click AutoFix, and Roxio PhotoSuite 10 analyzes the image and applies the necessary corrections.</p> <p>If desired, you can edit the image further with any of the other tools on the left tool panel.</p>	
<p>6. If you don't want to overwrite the original image, select it, then right click and choose Save As. PhotoSuite 10 opens the typical Save dialog you can use to save the edited file.</p> <p>Then click Alt-Tab to return to Roxio Media Manager.</p>	
<p>II. Optimizing photos for cell phone display with Mobile PhotoFit</p> <p>7. Back in Media Manager, choose the target image, then right click and Click Edit.</p> <p>This opens the image in Roxio PhotoSuite 10.</p>	
<p>8. In the tool panel on the left, Click Mobile Photo Tools, then click Mobile PhotoFit.</p>	
<p>9. In the Mobile PhotoFit configuration window, choose Portrait or Landscape.</p>	

10. Then choose the **Resolution** of your cell phone.

If you don't know the resolution of your cell phone screen, check the specifications page in your user manual.



11. Adjust **Crop Handles** to desired position.



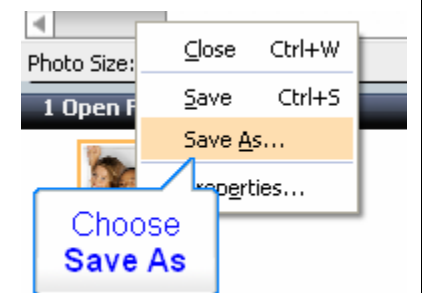
12. Click **Hide Cropped Area** for better preview.

13. After finalizing your edits, click **Apply**. Mobile PhotoFit applies your edits.



14. To avoid overwriting the photo, **select** it, then **right click** and choose **Save As**. PhotoSuite 10 opens the typical Save dialog you can use to save the edited file.

Then click **Alt-Tab** to return to Roxio Media Manager.



15. Back in Media Manager, **connect** your cell phone to your computer, then click **Copy Down** to copy the new images to your cell phone.
